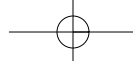

How can we help you?

Q What is a neurological condition?

Neurological conditions affect the brain, nervous system or spinal cord and include Epilepsy, Parkinson's disease, Multiple Sclerosis, Stroke, Alzheimer's disease, Brain tumour and Brain injury.

Q What is Neurosupport?

Neurosupport is a registered charity providing a non-medical starting point for people diagnosed with, or affected by, a neurological condition.

We can help with information needs regarding the condition and can signpost to sources of support and advice. We can provide help with issues regarding your current employment, or future employment needs.

We can offer advice on alternatives to employment and run a variety of short courses designed to restore confidence and improve quality of life.

Q Who is the Centre for?

Anyone with a neurological condition, their families and friends. Also for health and social care professionals and students with an interest in neurological conditions.

Q How are we funded?

As a registered charity we are responsible for raising all our funds to provide services to people with neurological conditions. All our services are free to individuals.



Q What facilities and services are available?

- Enquiry and information service from our library and information centre
- Employment advice and support from our Working Life Service
- Advice on courses and alternatives to employment
- Welfare benefits advice
- Counselling service
- Fully accessible meeting and conference facilities
- Regular support group meetings for various conditions
- Coffee bar

Q What else do we do?

- Organise and host events and conferences to raise awareness of neurological conditions
- Host the meetings of the Merseyside and Cheshire Neurological Alliance
- Office base for Alzheimer's Society, Mersey Regional Epilepsy Association, Motor Neurone Disease Association, Huntington's Disease Association and Advocacy Experience
